Leisure program

The learning journey continues as soon as classes finish! With our comprehensive leisure programme students have the opportunity to really discover their chosen destination.

A two-week language course generally includes a big variety of activities plus at least 1 full-day excursion and 2 half-day excursions (see table below for more details). Of course, students are also given some free time to socialise in the afternoons and evenings!



Supervision

Throughout the trip learners are accompanied by our "Teamers"; young adults between the ages of 20 and 30 who have been specially trained to accommodate the requirements of our young learners. Our Teamers come to us from all over Europe and America, and communicate with students exclusively in the language being taught. Each Teamer is responsible for the supervision of up to 15 students, travelling with the group, leading guided tours and activities, checking where the students

are going during their free time, as well as staying with them at the residence. Teamers are also responsible for the organisation of the leisure activity programme. Students aged 17 and under are expected to observe a curfew and follow the full leisure programme. Students aged between 18 and 20 also enjoy the complete support of the Teamers, and while not bound by the leisure programme, they are encouraged to take part in any activities which are of interest to them.

Our courses

Regardless of your choice of course, you'll develop your language ability both quickly and effectively. Our Standard Course, of 20 lessons per week, aims to give a dramatic boost to your confidence in a foreign language, with focused teaching in all 4 skill areas: speaking, listening, reading and writing. Our Intensive Course builds on our Standard Course, with 10 additional lessons per week, focusing on the fastest possible language acquisition.



The Standard Course generally takes place between 9:00 and 12:30, Monday to Friday.

Students who choose the Intensive Course have additional lessons between 13:00 and 14:30. Teaching times can occasionally vary, depending on the course location, and classes are sometimes held in the afternoon.

Each lesson consists of 45 minutes of learning.



Evaluation

Students are placed into classes according to their current language skills. The majority of our students take an online language test prior to commencing their programme, however if this is not available, students may take the exam on the first Monday of their course.

Learning materials are provided to students throughout their course, and class sizes are on average 15 students per class.

Transfer

Our U20 programmes offer the full package – students are in good hands from arrival to departure. Students will be picked up at the airport upon arrival and brought to their accommodation in comfort. For this, we require the student's full flight details at least 4 weeks before the course commencement.

Transfer time-windows vary depending on the destination and detailed information can be found on the individual school pages of this brochure. Students travel to and from the airport with their fellow classmates, most of whom they will be meeting for the first time.

The transfer provides students with the first of many opportunities to make new friends. Students generally check in to their accommodation in the afternoon, and vacate their room in the morning of the day of their departure. They may be asked to pay a key deposit when staying at a residence, which will be returned on their day of departure.



Meals, Allergies & Dietary Needs

We understand that sampling new food can play a big part in discovering a new country and its culture.

Students are provided with breakfast, dinner and either a cooked or packed lunch (which consists of a sandwich, a drink and a dessert/snack). Students always have the opportunity to try something typical of the country they are visiting.

Snacks outside of mealtime may be purchased by the student individually.

Each year we welcome thousands of students to our schools and boast over 35 years' experience in catering to students with a variety of dietary needs. We ask you to let us know of any allergies/dietary requirements

If you enjoy travelling, you can now experience a different country in a very special way – as an au pair. This is your chance to plunge into a whole new cultural experience. This programme is ideal, if you would like to make the most of your gap time, just before you start studying or working. To ensure that you have the correct foundations of your destination country's language, we can first teach you the fundamentals in one of our 30 centres worldwide and then help you to find the perfect host family. As an au pair, you'll experience your chosen culture first-hand, pick up the language quickly and also make lifelong friends. As your time as an au pair is certain to lead to you mastering the local language, this is the perfect example of how mutually beneficial being an au pair is for everyone involved. In some cases, families ask their au pairs to teach the children their native language.

1. How to apply

The first step to take is to fill in the application form. Afterwards you will receive detailed documents including the forms for references and the health certificate. A personal letter to your host family and an image collection will complete your application.

2. Finding the perfect host family

After a further check of your application it will be passed on to our colleagues at your destination. The families will contact you either by email, skype or telephone.

3. Becoming acquainted with your host family

Chemistry is, of course, of utmost importance. Therefore you will be introduced to carefully selected host families only. You will find this approach especially beneficial to your learning ambitions and a satisfying experience on the whole.

For several months you will be living with a host family, take care of their children and help with small housekeeping duties. Your working hours, length of stay and pocket money are depending on the host country.

Cancellation insurance is available at 2% of the total amount (minimum 45GBP/55EUR/55USD/70CAD). The insurance fee must be settled at the time of registration and will only apply if you cancel prior to departure due to health reasons (a written confirmation from the relevant doctor is required as proof). In the unlikely event the school is unable to create a group course due to an insufficient number of students of the same level, smaller classes for a reduced number of lessons will be provided instead (standard = 12 lessons / intensive = 18 lessons). The minimum number of participants is 4. Under the rare circumstances of our being forced to cancel, all fees paid for Teenagers Abroad services will be refunded.

- 4. Visa: In order to provide the letter of acceptance required by the embassy for issuing a visa, 40% of the total amount should be paid together with an additional charge of non-refundable 40 GBP/50 EUR/ 50 USD/ 65 CAD or equivalent (in USA and Canada this amount is included in the registration fee); non-refundable shipping fees may apply. In the case of visa refusal, a full refund minus the additional, non-refundable fees can only be made if the student provides the letter of refusal issued by the embassy at least 15 days before departure (evidence of visa refusal is required). After this date we will consider the participation of the student as confirmed and normal cancellation/rebooking charges will apply. In case the visa has not yet been issued 16 days before departure, we strongly recommend postponing the course. In this case, the first rebooking fee will not be charged.
- 5. Acceptable forms of payment: By bank transfer: The relevant account number will be on the invoice. Please send us a copy of the transfer order. All bank charges will be incurred by you.
